Project 1: Making Finger

Form five groups. Each group should make five finger puppets. You can make people, animals or you could make fairytale characters.



Write a few sentences about each finger puppet on a piece of paper, and stick it on to your puppet. Include common nouns, proper nouns, pronouns, verbs and adjectives in your sentences.

Example: I am Growly, the Tiger.

I can run, leap, pounce and growl.

Articles that may be used for making finger puppets:

gloves

wool/thread

pen caps

cloth

• ribbons.

cotton

glue

beads

a pair of scissors


• other decorative items

How to make a 'tiger' finger puppet—

- Cut off one finger of an old glove.
- Wrap a thick layer of cotton wool around it. Wrap more cotton on the top half so that it is thicker than the bottom half.
- Wrap a piece of yellow cloth over the cotton wool and stick it in place, using glue.
- Stick strips of black ribbon on the yellow cloth.
- Stick two black beads for the eyes.
- Stick one pink bead for the nose.
- Stick black thread for the whiskers.
- Cut out two ears from the yellow cloth and stick to the tiger's head.
- Slide the puppet onto your finger.

Project 2: Making a Sand Tray

Form three groups. Each group should make a sand tray model of one of these places—zoo, beach or park.



After making the sand tray, write some sentences about the model using prepositions.

Example: The girl is swinging on the bars.

Display your sand tray on a table in the class. Hang your chart, with the sentences on the wall, above the sand tray.

Tips

Remember to use:

- Prepositions
- Appropriate words

Articles that may be used for making a sand tray:

- a large cardboard tray
- pictures from old magazines and newspapers
- glue
- miniature toys
- branches and twigs

- sand
- cardboard or thick chart paper
- toothpicks or matchsticks
- paint or ink in different colours
- any other objects, as required

How to make a 'park' sand tray:

- Take a large cardboard tray and some sand.
- Mix green paint in one portion of the sand. Use this for grass.
- Mix blue paint in another portion of the sand. Use this for pond.
- Mix black or brown paint with a third portion of the sand. Use this
 for pathways.
- Spread the different coloured sand, as desired, on your tray.
- Stick coloured paper on matchboxes or paint them. Use them for stone benches.
- Use branches and twigs for trees, plants and bushes. You can also stick or paint flowers on the plants.
- Cut out pictures of people and animals from old magazines and newspapers.
- Stick these pictures on cardboard or thick chart paper.
- Attach toothpicks or matchsticks to your pictures to make them stand on your tray.
- Place them in various positions on the tray.
- Some people could sit on the benches and others could walk on the pathways. Some children could be playing. Some ducks could be swimming in the pond.
- You can also place playthings such as slide, swing and see-saw in your park.
